REMINDER to all participants in the MedFSA plan, you have until March 15, 2018 to incur expenses for your 2017 balances. You will then have until March 31, 2018 to submit your claims to Benefits Connection. Any claim received after March 31, 2018 will not be eligible for reimbursement. Deductibles Reset each January

Remember that each year on Jan.1, the deductibles and out-of-pocket maximums begin again for the CMCSS Group Health Plan. As a reminder, the amounts are as follows:


